Budget can be reviewed at a committee meeting suggested for 4pm April 20. Discussion about signage and placement options. Discussion about tables for the park. Concerns about the new fees proposed by the City for vendors (suggested \$20 for vendors). Fears that vendors would not participate if vendor fees are too excessive. Chamber would like to work with the City to review the fee structure for vendor businesses. Chamber may attend the May City Council meeting to comment. CG: looking for accessible shed for plastics storage; Mechele offers her shed. Set a date for a farmers market committee meeting: April 20, 2023, 4pm, at Mechele's house.

- Music & Arts Festival (September 9) Bruce, Pat, Kerri, Mechele: committee meetings TBD. Grants have been approved for a total of \$7000 to market the music festival.

The Chamber has no budget to hire live music on Sunday so suggesting "canned" music since the stage might still be available for part of the day; need to determine if offering 2 days for vendors. - BTAC Marketing Jan Z. Reported that the KIOSK repairs are being delayed due to struggles to find a repair person for the window display panels (repair materials list has been misplaced); thoughts on other information to be included on the KIOSK one the panels are weather proof; magnetic backboard; \$1500 is budgeted for this repair. JHS welded sign \$425.00 for materials; gift cards for students for their work \$250 to Sweet Spot -Jan needs checks to cover welded sign. Bozeman/Belgrade airport to be paid \$250 for brochure distribution (yet to be invoiced). \$1000.00 for musician at Music Festival. Boulder brochure included an error for the city's website address. Resolved by asking EDGE (the Chamber's web host) to secure the url and forward to the correct address for the city for two years, \$40. Board discussed the BTAC marketing committee's budget. All funds held by BACC on behalf of BTAC are now spoken for. Additional funding sources will be researched for marketing.
- ReImagine Boulder Mechele: MA reported on updates and progress. Setting August 27 as a "Connie Smith" day and art display event with activities tentatively partnering up with other Main Street businesses. Working with Animal Shelter organization for their dog park.
